### **SMI Symptoms/Characteristics/Medications**

**January 13th, July 13th**

Topics include: Multi-axial assessment; Decomposition-signs and symptoms; General Interventions; Schizophrenia; Borderline Personality Disorders; PTSD; Bi-Polar; Depression; Mental Retardation; Pervasive Developmental Disorder. This also includes training on **MEDICATIONS**; Procedures/Forms and Names, Side-effects, etc. (Trainers: Christin Calderon, along with a medical practitioner)

### **Developing your Therapeutic Skills**

**February 10th, August 10th**

Topics include: Building an appropriate therapeutic rapport with those who have Co-occurring disorders, including chemical dependency; empathy and skill development; encouraging coping skills with mental illness; (Trainer: Chris Ledyard)

### **Clinical Documentation Skills**

**March 9th, September 14<sup>th</sup>**

Topics include: Service Plan development and reporting progress; writing skills; OBHL requirements regarding documentation will be reviewed. The SROC and CIR procedures and documentation methods will be discussed. (Trainers: Christin Calderon, Jeff Amberson)

### **Ethics and Cultural Diversity**

**April 13th, October 12<sup>th</sup>**

Topics include: cultural competency: ethical behavior, such as respecting staff and consumer boundaries; confidentiality of consumers' records and information protection and maintenance. (Trainers: Rich Ebbens, and Christin Calderon, Danny Opacich)

### **General Safety & Annual Safety Update**

**May 11th, November 9<sup>th</sup>**

Training topics include: Bloodborne Pathogens, fire extinguisher training, first aid summary and review. (Trainers: Christin Calderon & United Fire)

### **Annual Recertification in CPI**

**Weekly**

This will include training in prevention of crisis situations and what to do in case of aggression, DTO, DTS behaviors. This training is **ONLY** for those who already took the initial CPI training prior to employment start date. (Trainers: Elaine Daves & Sarah Bree)
